### Directions

**1 lb. = 3 Cups**

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when feeding your plants.

### New Plantings

Dig a hole twice as wide and the same depth as the root ball. Remove ½ of the soil and replace with compost, peat moss or Espoma Organic Garden Soil.

Mix Tree-tone® into the amended soil at the rates in the chart below.

Place the plant in the hole so that it sits at the same depth it was previously growing (use soil mark on the trunk as a guide).

Fill the hole with amended soil. Pack firmly, soak with water, and allow to settle. Add additional soil if needed.

Add mulch to help conserve water and control weeds.

Keep well watered until plant is established.



### Established Trees

#### When to Feed:

Feed twice each year: In early Spring before growth starts and in Fall after leaves drop but before ground freezes.

**How Much to Feed:** Follow the rates in the below chart.

#### How to Apply:

**Small Trees** - Sprinkle Tree-tone around the drip line of the plant

**Large Trees** - (over 6 inch trunk diameter) Make a series of 3 inch wide holes, 12-18 inches deep, 2-3 feet apart, under the drip line of the plant. Divide the Tree-tone evenly and pour into holes. Backfill holes with soil and water thoroughly.

Trunk Diameter	Application Rate
Up to 2 inches	3 lbs. (9 cups per inch)
2 - 4 inches	4 lbs. (12 cups per inch)
4 - 6 inches	5 lbs. (15 cups per inch)
Over 6 inches	6 lbs. (18 cups per inch)
